Lauren's campaign slogan as a state officer was "HEART - STYLE - SMILE". She truly lived by those words—serving with heart, demonstrating leadership with style, and always wearing a smile.

To honor her legacy, the 2018-2019 SkillsUSA Oklahoma State Team created this award to recognize outstanding SkillsUSA student members who embody Lauren's spirit of service, leadership, and compassion.

### What is Lauren's Legacy Leadership Award?

This award celebrates a SkillsUSA student who consistently demonstrates a heart for service, a commitment to their community and fellow members, and the ability to lead by example with kindness and dedication.
